RULES OF BEHAVIOUR

*Welcome to the Italian Air Force Historical Museum of Vigna di Valle. Below are some simple instructions to help you enjoy a pleasant day in our company. A certain number of **audioguides** are available at the reception, which can be requested upon issuing an identity document, which will be returned at the end of your visit when the device is returned. **The audioguide service is free.** An **APP** is also available, which can be downloaded from the stores, for a convenient use of the visit (MUSAM – for Android and iOS devices)*

HOW TO PARK AT THE MUSEUM

Buses, cars, caravans, campers, bicycles, motorcycles must be parked in the designated areas. From the car park to the Museum entrance, visitors will have to proceed on foot, with the exception of disabled people who have a reserved car park adjacent to the Museum entrance. If places are full, access to the private vehicle will be permitted unless it is subsequently returned by the companion (where present) to the car park.

WHICH RULES TO BE RESPECTED

Visitors are NOT ALLOWED to:

- enter the Museum with packages, suitcases, bags, backpacks, umbrellas, sticks, helmets: please leave anything not strictly necessary for the visit inside your vehicles; a wardrobe is also available in the atrium;
- enter bare-chested, in a bathing suit, or in clothing inappropriate for the place;
- introduce and consume food and drinks along the exhibition route;
- smoking inside the Museum;
- cross the boundaries around memorabilia and aircraft;
- touching and tampering the displays and aircraft on display;
- make use of the emergency exits without any serious reason;
- access the beach in front of the Museum.



Visitors are **ALLOWED** to:

- carry a lady's handbag;
- use the wardrobe, as provided;
- use the camera for shots and filming for personal and amateur use only. Any photographs or filming for commercial purposes must be previously authorized by the Air Force General Staff;
- introduce small animals, carried in the arms or in a special carrier. In the Outside there are many green areas where pets can be kept on a leash;

VISITS FOR ORGANIZED GROUPS AND SCHOOLS

BOOKING IS MANDATORY FOR ORGANIZED GROUPS.

NO RESERVATION IS REQUIRED FOR SINGLE VISITORS OR WITH FAMILY.

Group visits must be requested according to the procedure below. Compatibly with the availability of staff on duty, a free guided tour can be requested.

The visiting group must comply with the rules of behavior and good manners dictated by the Management both with regard to the staff present and with regard to the cultural assets of the collection; **if necessary, the visit may be interrupted at any time.** In the case of a guided tour, the group must follow the guide's instructions. **In case of delay,** the group leader is required to communicate it to the reception (06.99.88.75.19) to evaluate the availability of the guide. **In case of delays of more than 30 minutes which are not communicated, the group may lose the right to the guide.**

How to book a visit to the Museum

Only in the case of organized groups, and to verify the possibility of enjoying a guided tour:

OTHER NOTICES

Groups who intend to use their own guide must pay the Company a €1.00 per person booking fee.

Mandatory use of earphones for groups

Considering the need, given the high number of visitors, to maintain an atmosphere inside the Museum that is as silent and respectful as possible, starting from September 1, 2024, groups of more than 10 people (excluding the guide) are required to provide themselves with earphones and a microphone in order to allow those providing information to keep their voices low. Those who do not have personal earphones can rent them inside the museums, by booking at visitamusam@csmusei.it at a cost of €1.50 each.

The following are excluded from using earphones:

students in nursery, primary and lower secondary schools; people with disabilities; students in nursery, primary and lower secondary school groups who participate in activities and/or visits assisted by Museum operators.
