Since August 2022 Air Marshal Johnny Stringer CBE MA RAF, has been the Deputy Commander of NATO's Allied Air Command, headquartered at Ramstein Air Base, Germany. As Deputy Commander he is responsible to the Commander Allied Air Command for the Air and Missile Defence of NATO Alliance member nations during peacetime operations. He ensures the preservation of Alliance territorial integrity from Northern Norway to Southern Italy and from the Azores to Eastern Türkiye, including every European NATO nation. Furthermore, he is the Deputy Commander of NATO's Combined Force Space Component.
